The Housing Outreach Team is a program offered through the Canadian Mental Health Association, in partnership with Health PEI.

This program aims to support individuals to secure and maintain independent living. The Housing Outreach Team provides support for individuals experiencing mental health and addictions issues, and who face other barriers to stable housing as well. Individuals engaged in the program will receive aid with the following:

- Securing independent housing in the community
 Developing daily living skills
- Planning for their transition to independence
- Support accessing community resources

Housing Outreach Team works closely with the participants to secure housing, and to develop key daily living skills; with the goal of transitioning to independent living within six months to one year.

Candidates must be willing to engage in the supports offered by the Housing Outreach workers, and engage in a transition plan. As well as participate in regular home visits.





Candidates living across PEI may be referred to the Housing Outreach team.
