The loss of a former team member to suicide inspired family, friends, and co-workers to come together and help raise awareness and funds for suicide prevention efforts in their community. From that collaboration, and through the organization's pension for parody, Moo Let's Talk was created. It's been a wonderful success raising a cumulative total of \$172,000 to date.

**On March 22nd COWS is hosting its seventh annual Moo Let's Talk Day!** On that day, 100% of the proceeds from ice cream cones sold at the COWS Creamery and Queen Street locations will go to the Canadian Mental Health Association, PEI Division.

Once again, COWS will host at both of their Charlottetown locations: COWs Creamery at 12 Milky Way, and their 150 Queen Street location. All 32 Moo-valous flavours of COWS ice cream will be available, and you can get yours in a cup or an ice cream cone. CMHA PEI staff will be present in stores to promote awareness of our programs and services and, more importantly, to help provide a safe space to "Talk until the COWS come home!"

Promotional efforts will start on March 8th over social media, with video content featuring Patrick Ledwell and a radio campaign starting closer to the event date. During the event, updates will be posted on our Facebook and Instagram, and a live remote with Ocean 100 will remind people to come on down and grab an ice cream cone in support of CMHA.
